Students are required to complete their AP exam registration by the published deadlines. This includes registering for all intended exams, paying the exam fee directly to the designated AP Test Center, and following the full process outlined in the AP Exam Registration Policy. Please note that deadlines are final, and no extensions will be provided.

REGISTRATION & PAYMENT INSTRUCTIONS

Complete ALL STEPS BELOW (register online and pay at the test center) latest by February 20, 2026, to reserve your seat. The Test Center will provide an AP Admission Ticket by April 30, 2026, as confirmation that your seat is reserved.

YOU WILL NOT BE ABLE TO REGISTER IF:

- You register online with the College Board but do not pay at the test center
- You pay but do not complete the online registration (form attached below).

TO START: Use a phone, tablet, or computer to complete registration online with the College Board. View [Tutorial](#).

1. SIGN IN TO MY AP

Sign in to myap.collegeboard.org using the same College Board student account login you have used to view AP, SAT, or PSAT scores, or to register for the SAT or AP before. Create an account if you do not already have one.

2. JOIN AN EXAM

Click the Join a Course or Exam button

3. STEPS FOR REGISTRATION

Submit your join code on the App, valid [only for the first registration till Feb 20, 2025.](#)

Click on the '[Center Registration form](#)' to complete the process and get the Join Code.

4. VERIFY EXAM INFORMATION

Confirm the exam name, exam date, and test center name. Click the Join a Course or Exam button.

5. FILL OUT REGISTRATION INFORMATION

The first time you register in My AP, you'll need to fill out some registration information. Provide accurate information- this will be on your personalized AP labels for exam day. You only have to do this once.

Repeat steps 2-4 for the exam you wish to take.

6. RECEIVE ADMISSION TICKET FROM THE TEST CENTER

The test center will provide you with an admission ticket after they have ordered your exams. Tickets will be provided before or by **April 30, 2026**. This ticket is a confirmation that your seat has been reserved. You will need this ticket on exam day, along with an original, **Valid Passport & PVC Aadhar Card**, or you will **not** be able to take the test.

- The student should bring their **OWN APPROVED TESTING DEVICE** to the test centre on exam day, or else they will not be able to test. Device requirements

I acknowledge that:

- I am currently studying in school.
- I will need to pay the test center and register online with the College Board by the stated deadline to complete my AP Exam registration and receive an Admission Ticket from the test center, or I will not be able to appear for the test.
- I have read and agree to the test center policies above, with respect to the payment deadline, payment instructions, refunds, and cancellations.
- I will bring my **Admission Ticket** along with an original, **VALID PASSPORT or PVC AADHAR CARD** to the test center on exam day, or I will not be able to test.

ID Policy for test centers in India:

Please plan any ID processing and applications in advance. Ensure you have acceptable ID to bring to the test site on exam day or you will not be able to test.

- AP-authorized test centers in India will only accept an original, valid passport as ID for entry to the AP Exam administration.

- If an original, valid passport is not available, the student must present the Aadhaar either in the original letter format or the PVC version with a hologram (both issued by UIDAI). No other Aadhaar versions will be accepted.
- A sample of the **letter version** is shown on the left; it's the entire piece of paper and not just the card portion at the bottom. The **PVC** card sample is on the right.



Please note that:

- No soft copies of ID proof will be accepted
- Visa applications or ID renewals should be planned in advance
- You have a valid ID in hand on test day.
